

## - Martial Activities -

### **ARMORED COMBAT**

Armored tournaments will start immediately following morning court, as follows:

#### • Her Majesty's 6-Foot Spear Tournament

This will be run in a speed tournament format, using two matched 6 foot spears. Open to all combatants authorized in two handed thrust. Please bring gauntlets.

#### • POOL TOURNEY

*A "pool style" tournament, until a final tree of combatants is determined. The final tree will be a single elimination bracket to determine the winner.* 

#### • CHRISTIANS VS. LIONS

A harkening to the barbarian past in our "Christians versus the Lion" tournament. (We hope to have a ransom paid out in period coin!)

#### • All-Day Pick-Up Area

An all-day pick-up area (weather permitting) including the famous teeter-totter boards!

All fighters MUST present their blue card, authorization card and site token (hand stamp) at the list tables before signing in to fight — THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO "VOUCHING" FOR FIGHTERS.

### **THROWN WEAPONS**

Please note that Thrown Weapons are weather-dependent and may run intermittently.

The usual fare is Knife, Ax, Spear, and Atlatl. Thanks to the wood working skill of Forester Liges we have atl-atl throwing sticks in four different lengths for you to try this year. I also have a new set of throwing knifes. *Come by give them a try!* 

Competition will be a **Grand Slam of All Forms:** The throw will be three axes, three knifes, three spears, and three darts. The highest score wins the darts.

### **RAPIER COMBAT**

#### • DICE BEAR PIT

Roll dice based on your awards and experience fencing, to determine what style you take on the field. Winner stays bear pit, with a point per win, but wounds are retained starting with wounds taken on your third pass. Double kills are re-fought once, then dead is dead. Re-roll each time you get in line. Multiple pits will be opened based on attendance.

#### • Pools Challenge Tourney

*Fencers will be split into pools, and will fight round-robin within those pools. Each pool will decide amongst themselves which styles they want to use, whether that be a simple style like single sword, bring your best, or something less standard such as cloak and dagger.* (Note: Intent is to allow C&T as well)

#### • DOUBLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT

*A standard double elimination tournament. Bring your best, bring your A-game. Each bout is best 2 out of 3, double kills re-fought until there is a clear victor.* 

#### • MELEE PRACTICE

Melee games and training lead by Warder AElfwine Pyttel (Note: Details TBD)

#### • Cut & Thrust Prowess Tournament

This round-robin tournament will be scored in the following fashion: each pair of combatants will fight three bouts. If you are struck, you earn zero points for that bout (double-kills result in zero points for both). If you strike your opponent on a limb without being struck, you earn one point for the bout. If you strike your opponent on the head or body without being struck, you earn two points for the bout. The person with the greatest number of points at the end of the tournament is the winner.

#### • ARMOUR AS WORN TOURNAMENT

This round-robin tournament will be scored in a similar fashion as the C&T prowess tournament, except that armour will be treated as worn. Plate steel is impervious. Maille, coat of plates, lamellar, etc are proof against cuts, but a continuing thrust delivered with positive pressure will penetrate. Padded gambesons and leather prevent some incidental cuts and light thrusts. Modern materials such as manufactured perforated steel, butcher/shark mail, fencing masks, and plastic will not be counted as armor.

### **Exchequer Class**


"Being the Exchequer and What that Means" • 12-2 p.m. in classroom #9 The position of exchequer can be daunting and a little confusing. This class will review the procedures for becoming an exchequer and what to do afterwards. We will review the handbook and kingdom financial policies as well as go over reports and deadlines and procedures for day to day handling of group funds. This class counts for the exchequer warranting requirements. Please bring your laptops with downloaded copies of the MK financial policies and SCA Local Exchequer handbook or printed copies of each.

## - Day Camps -
